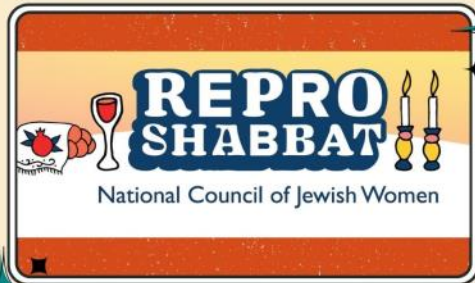

As current Maccabi USA President, Jeff has dedicated over four decades to an organization that he was predestined to be a part of. Jeff's father, Dan, competed and won a gold medal in individual foil at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Maccabiah in 1950, only two short years after Israel's establishment. A little over 30 years later, Jeff found himself following in his father's footsteps at the 11<sup>th</sup> Maccabiah going for gold in individual foil. From there, Jeff's passion and dedication for Maccabi USA grew and has led him to the top of the organization that he so dearly loves. From Jeff's dedication to the Maccabi Movement and a lifetime of achievements, he has been selected as one of the recipients of the Yakir Maccabi Award, the highest and most prestigious honor given by Maccabi World Union.

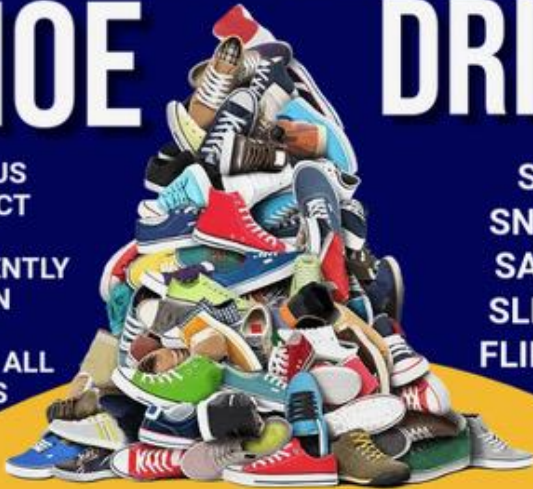

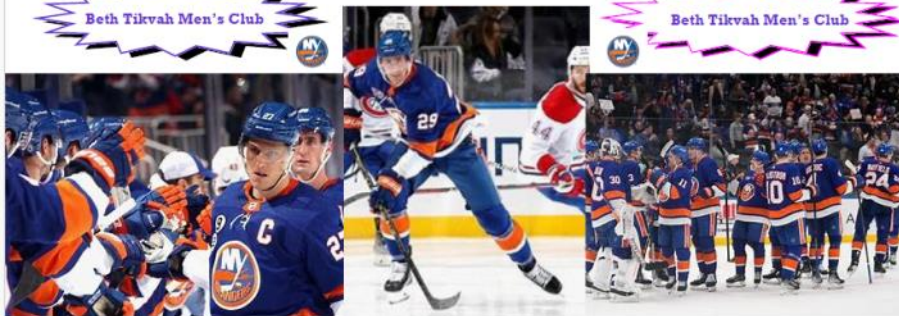

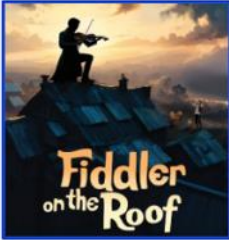
