## The Daily Minyans

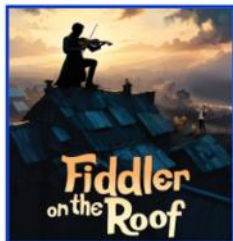
It is good to remember that while Minyans are necessary to help mourners who are saying Kaddish, they also provide an opportunity to recite the Misheberach (healing) prayers.
